

Maharashtra Quarterly Performance Review of Blocks under Aspirational Block development Program

"Progress and Impact Assessment of Aspirational Blocks in Maharashtra: A Multi-Sectoral Approach to Sustainable Development"

Introduction

The Aspirational Blocks Programme (ABP), launched by NITI Aayog as an extension of the Aspirational Districts Programme (ADP), targets 500 underdeveloped blocks across 330 districts in 27 states and 4 Union Territories, **with a vision to saturate key social services and drive inclusive growth**. In Maharashtra, a state balancing economic progress with regional disparities, the ABP focuses on blocks within aspirational districts such as Nandurbar, Osmanabad, Washim, and Gadchiroli, among others. **The programme, operational since its baseline in March 2023, builds on a robust framework of 39 Key Performance Indicators (KPIs) across five thematic areas—Health & Nutrition (30% weightage), Education (30%), Agriculture and Allied Services (20%), Basic Infrastructure (15%), and Social Development (5%)—aligned with six Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs 3, 4, 6, 8, 9, 10). These KPIs, directly sourced from Central Ministry databases, ensure data integrity and reduce administrative burden**, with the first delta ranking released in 2023 reflecting progress between March and June.

Rooted in the 3Cs Approach—**Convergence of Central and State schemes, Collaboration among stakeholders, and Competition among blocks—the ABP fosters a mass movement for development**. In its inaugural year, over 4,500 block-level officials underwent leadership training, culminating in the creation of Block Development Strategies (BDS) through extensive Chintan Shivirs involving local representatives, SHG members, frontline workers, and sectoral experts. In Maharashtra, the programme leverages the state's population (25% weight) and per capita GDP (75% weight) to select blocks, ensuring at least one block per aspirational district among the 112 nationwide, with 154 of the 500 blocks drawn from such districts based on Antyodaya data and SECC insights.

This report evaluates Maharashtra's **27 aspirational blocks across 15 districts** as of March 18, 2025, assessing progress across the five themes, each overseen by 11 nodal ministries and departments responsible for 39 KPIs.

- 1) **Health & Nutrition**, managed by the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare (MoHFW) and Ministry of Women & Child Development (MWCD),
 - 2) **Education** under the Department of School Education & Literacy (DoSEL),
 - 3) **Agriculture and Allied Services** led by the Department of Agriculture & Farmers Welfare (DAFW), Department of Animal Husbandry & Dairying (DAHD), and Department of Water Resources (DoWR),
 - 4) **Basic Infrastructure** driven by the Department of Drinking Water & Sanitation (DDWS), Department of Telecommunications (DoT), and Ministry of Rural Development (MoRD), and
 - 5) **Social Development** guided by MoRD, Department of Financial Services (DFS), and Ministry of Electronics & Information Technology (MeitY) form the backbone of this analysis.
- By providing district-wise rankings and actionable scheme focuses, this report aims to guide stakeholders in optimizing resources, addressing gaps, and accelerating Maharashtra's journey toward sustainable development.
